MINE DEVELOPMENT AND ORE EXCAVATION CONTRACT

1. PURPOSE

This call for tenders is part of the DIANDA mining project covered by the PEs 529 and 2350, initiated by CHEMAF SA. Qualified and experienced contractors are invited to submit bids for the **mine development and ore excavation contract at Dianda.**

2. PROJECT DETAILS

- **Project:** Mine development and ore excavation
- **Place of execution:** Dianda, Lualaba Province in the Democratic Republic of the Congo
- **Contract Duration:** 1 Year
- **Mine development volume:** 200,000 m³ per month, 2.4 million m³ per year
- **Ore excavation volume:** 60,000 m³ per month, 720,000 m³ per year
- **Maximum haul distance:** 1 km

3. SCOPE OF WORK

The successful contractor shall be responsible for the following:

- Executing mine development and ore excavation activities to achieve the required monthly production targets;
- Deploying suitable mining equipment that is in good operating condition;
- Providing qualified and experienced operators, supervisors, and skilled manpower;
- Deploying all necessary supporting equipment to ensure efficient and uninterrupted mining operations;
- Supplying diesel for all contractor-owned equipment and machinery;

- Carrying out water sprinkling for dust suppression throughout the operational areas;
- Complying with all Chemaf health, safety, environmental, and operational requirements.

4. CONTRACTOR REQUIREMENTS

Interested contractors shall demonstrate:

- Proven experience in large-scale open-pit mining operations;
- All the equipment should be after 2020 manufacture;
- Availability of the required mining fleet and supporting equipment;
- Capability to mobilize personnel and equipment within the required timeframe;
- Qualified technical and supervisory personnel;
- Strong health, safety, and environment (HSE) management systems;
- Financial and technical capability to successfully execute the contract;
- Required area lighting

5. CHEMAF SCOPE

- Provide land for camp and workshop;
- Provide mine plan;
- Provide proper disposal land and stockpile land

6. ELIGIBILITY REQUIREMENTS

In accordance with the Congolese legislation in force, only subcontractors who meet the following criteria are allowed to apply:

- Be a company with majority Congolese capital (in accordance with Law 17/001);
- Be registered and approved by the **ARSP**;



- Provide proof of legal existence and be in good standing with the tax and social administration (RCCM, Nat ID, Tax Number, Tax Receipt, CNSS Membership Certificate, Articles of Association, INPP Registration Certificate, Ministerial Order, Medical Agreement, etc.)

7. SUBMITTING THE FILE

Qualified contractors are invited to submit their technical and commercial proposals in accordance with the tender requirements. Detailed tender documents, including submission instructions and evaluation criteria will be provided for shortlisted bidders.
