1. Company Presentation

2. Objective

The Company hereby invites tenders from qualified and experienced technical agencies to provide Blasting service in the Kibolwe (PE-14952) mines.

3. Scope of Work

Blasting Services at PE-14952-Kibolwe Mines, Likasi, Haut Katanga, DRC, as per the discussion. The scope includes:

- Technical manpower services to conduct blasting as per the Company’s instructions as mentioned below

- The Contractor shall provide qualified and certified manpower as listed above, in compliance with DRC laws. The listed manpower is minimum; additional personnel may be deployed as required.
- The Contractor shall obtain all required blasting permits and approvals and coordinate with relevant government authorities.
- The Contractor shall be responsible for procurement, transport, storage, and handling of explosives and accessories, unless otherwise specified by the Company. However, the payment for the explosive and accessories shall be paid by the company directly to the explosive supplier.
- The Contractor, in coordination with the Company, shall execute the full blasting cycle, including:
 - Inspection of blasting areas
 - Preparation of blast design, drilling plan and obtaining approval from the Company
 - Marking and checking of blast holes
 - Charging of explosives and stemming
 - Wiring and continuity testing
 - Pre-blast safety checks and clearance
 - Controlled blasting wherever necessary
 - Post-blast inspection and fragmentation assessment
 - Secondary blasting if necessary
 - Safety clearance of the area
 - Restricting unauthorized access until “all-clear”

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- The Contractor is fully responsible for the performance, supervision, and conduct of its personnel.
- If work is not completed within the agreed timeframe, the Contractor shall continue work at its own cost until completion.
- Working hours shall be mutually agreed based on project requirements.
- The Contractor shall provide proper PPE to all personnel as per Company standards.
- The Contractor shall ensure full safety control at site, including exclusion zones, warning systems, and access control.
- The Contractor shall be fully responsible for any accidents, injuries, damages, or environmental impact during the work.
- In case of misfire, the Contractor shall jointly investigate with the Company, document findings, and resume work only after clearance.
- The Contractor shall provide all required equipment, tools, machinery, maintenance, consumables, and fuel (unless otherwise specified).
- The Contractor shall provide transportation, communication, salaries, and benefits to personnel as per DRC law.
- All equipment must meet safety standards and be properly maintained.
- The Contractor shall provide medical support and insurance for all personnel.
- The Contractor shall prepare and submit risk assessments before starting work, and ensure all personnel are briefed.
- The Contractor shall provide a Safety Management System (SMS) and Standard Operating Procedures (SOPs) before mobilization.
- The Contractor shall maintain proper documentation for each blast and submit to the company, including:
 - Blast design and drill pattern
 - Explosive calculations and charging records
 - Wiring diagrams
 - Inspection and clearance reports
- The Contractor shall attend daily safety meetings and toolbox talks.
- The Contractor shall submit daily reports covering work progress and any HSE incidents.
- The Contractor shall provide all other necessary services unless specifically assigned to the Company.

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4. Instructions to Bidders

4.3 Deadline Submissions must be received no later than **May 15, 2026**.

4.4 Mandatory Documentation Bidders must provide the following documents to be considered eligible:

1. **Letter of Submission:** Signed by an authorized company representative.
2. **Company Profile:** Detailing organizational structure and core competencies.
3. **Regulatory Compliance:** Valid **ARSP registration certificate** (Mandatory).
4. **Legal Credentials:** RCCM and National Identification (ID NAT).
5. **Tax/Social Standing:** NIF, VAT certificate, Tax Clearance, and ONEM registration.
6. **Technical Track Record:** Evidence of expertise and a list of completed projects over the last five years.
7. **Resource List:** Inventory of available equipment and technical assets.
8. **Key Personnel:** CVs of proposed main collaborators and senior supervisors.
9. **Insurance & Liability:** Provide comprehensive equipment insurance and workers' insurance for all personnel.

5. Selection Process
